1. Short for ampere, a measurement of electrical current. One coulomb flowing per second. Amperage. Abbreviated A or amp. Practical unit of electrical current; the current flow rate (quantity of electrons passing a point in 1 second). Voltage of 1 volt will send a current of 1 ampere through a resistance of 1 ohm.

2. Short for Amphenol, a company that pioneered various forms of connectors and plugs in the electrical industry. See them at HTTP://WWW.AMPHENOL.COM.

3. Short for amplifier, a term used for devices that increase output of sound or electrical voltage or current.
